Book Sales at the Souvenir Market:

The Adams River Salmon Society's "Salute to the Sockeye" is an event that celebrates a diversity of cultures, heritages and conservation. The "Salute to the Sockeye" Committee wishes to reflect those same principles in its book sales. We would like to feature authors that focus on the salmon and/or wildlife or nature of the Tsútswecw Provincial Park (formally Roderick Haig-Brown Park) (such as bears, beavers, bats, trees and other plants). The books can be fiction, non-fiction, photography, poetry or children's.

The Souvenir Market space is prominently located on the site and is a busy and popular area of the "Salute to the Sockeye."

The Adams River Salmon Society will provide:

- * Covered display space
- * maintain adequate sales staff during all hours of operations during the run
- * documentation of each sales
- * maintain debit/credit card machines and cash sales
- * collect taxes applicable
- * On-site security, garbage removal, First Aid services

* A table for authors to sign their books. This table will be on a sign-up basis to give fair access to all authors.

The Authors are to provide:

* Lists of the book(s) complete with retail prices. All items will be priced at the same rate that they are sold for in any other locations.

* Authors are expected to maintain as full a stock of items as possible at the Souvenir Market for the duration of the "Salute to the Sockeye", excluding of course, those items sold during the Salute.

* Authors are expected to insure their own items. The Salmon Society insurance is not applicable to commission sale books.

* The Adams River Salmon Society requests the donation of one book by each Author to be used in the Society's fundraising activities.

* Provide a synopsis of the book as well as a bio of the author

Sales Commission:

* The Adams River Salmon Society is to receive 16% commission on the retail price of the book (before taxes and before credit/debit card fees)

* The Society will keep complete and accurate records of sales daily so that at the

conclusion of the 2018 "Salute to the Sockeye" the Commission accounts may be readily settled.

There are no reserved display spaces. Market layout is pre-planned, and spaces are designated at the Society's discretion.

All work must be dropped off at Tsútswecw Provincial Park between 10 am and 3 pm Wednesday, September 26th and Thursday, September 27th, 2018

Submission Process - All Applicants are required to submit one clear photo of jacket cover; book synopsis and author bio Please complete the Application Form in full and return with and other supporting documentation to the postal or e-mail address below. The selection process is based on the inclusion of a variety of types of books from fiction, non-fiction, photography, poetry and children's as well as their topic.
