

Salute to the Sockeye Festival

30 September – 23 October 2022 Artisan Market Application Form

The **"Salute to the Sockeye Festival**" is an event that celebrates a diversity of cultures, heritages and conservation. As hosts of the Salute, The Adams River Salmon Society (The Society) and the Little Shuswap Lake Band (LSLB) wish to reflect the same principles in its Artisan Market. We would like to feature local Indigenous and non-Indigenous artists of various disciplines, who create their own hand-made items that focus on salmon and/or Tsútswecw Provincial Park.

The Artisan Market space is prominently located on the site and is a busy and popular area of the "Salute to the Sockeye Festival".

It will operate during the 24 days of the Salute to the Sockeye Festival.

The Society will:

• Provide on-site security from the time the Salute closes until the time the Salute re-opens each day.

Artisans will:

- Select and pay for participation and set -up during the entire Salute to the Sockeye Festival September 30-October 23rd, 2022 Payments are required on or before **31 August 2022**.
- Provide their own 10x10 market canopy and table/display needs.
- Provide a list of their items complete with retail prices.
- Maintain as full a stock of items as possible at all times.
- Insure their own items. The Society is not responsible for lost, broken or stolen goods.
- Not offer for sale any items that are not uniquely created by each artisan.



There are no reserved spaces. The Artisan Market layout is pre-planned, and spaces are designated at a first-come first-served basis. All spaces are in an open area where the public will be able to view all the artisans that are on site.

Artisan Market Hours of Operation - Sept 30-Oct 23, 2022

10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m, daily

Set-Up Hours

Artisans must complete set-up prior to 10:00 a.m. each day.

Artisans may commence take-down no earlier than 4:00 p.m. each day.

Submission Process

All Applicants are required to submit one clear photo or sample of each category of item being sold. If you submit photos, please include a written description of each item with its corresponding photograph. Photos and samples will be returned to you at the "Salute to the Sockeye Festival" or mailed to you.

Please complete the Application Form in full and return it with other supporting documentation to the postal address or e-mail address below on or before **August 10th**, **2022**.
