
Salute to the Sockeye

Preference will be given to non-profit community groups and First Nations food vendor applicants. We encourage environmentally friendly practices as per listed.

FOOD VENDOR APPLICATION

FOR THE SALMON RUN AT TSUTSWECW PROVINCIAL PARK FOR THANKSGIVING WEEKEND: OCT. 12TH, 13TH AND 14TH 2019

Under the supervision of The Adams River Salmon Society, for the period October 12, 2019 to October 14, 2019 (Sat, Sun, & Mon), concession vendors will meet the following conditions:

Health and Safety Requirements:

The food vendor booth must meet the standards under the BC Health Temporary Food Service Regulations and must display a valid BC Temporary Food Concession Permit. All food vendor information will be shared with the Health Department and the Health Inspector may contact you in advance.

The food vendor equipment on site, shall be clean, in good repair, will be operated in a safe and environmentally responsible manner at all times.

The Food vendor is responsible to contain and dispose of off-site the garbage they generate for the weekend

The Food Vendors are required to pick up garbage around the table/concession area and place all garbage to an 'off site' transfer station, not the BC Parks garbage receptacles.

The food vendors will agree to not use plastic or styrofoam disposable tableware. Food Vendor will agree to use **biodegradable**, environmentally friendly tableware (plates, cups, cutlery, stir sticks).

The Food vendors is encouraged to use biodegradable, environmentally friendly soap (phosphate free) and cleaners during the course of the event.

Concessions must conform to BC electrical and building codes including a valid BC Electrical Inspection sticker or an Inspection Certificate posted on the premises.

The food vendor must comply with the BC Fire Code required - CAN/ULC 1254 Standard.

Salmon Food Products and Menus

The Vendor may serve only <u>wild salmon</u> and <u>wild salmon products</u> at Tsútswecw Park All food vendors applicants will provide a copy of their menu with their application. Changes can be submitted via email to <u>info@salmonsociety.com</u> at later dates but will be subject to approval by the Society.

Setup and Take down

Set up and take down of market facilities & structures should be performed safely, without delay, and shall not impede public access to local Park trails and facilities

Liability Requirements:

The food vendor, without limiting its obligations or liabilities herein and at its own expense, will insure its operations under a policy of comprehensive general liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 inclusive per occurrence against bodily injury, personal injury, property damage and including liability assumed under contract.

The Adams River Salmon Society and the Province of BC are to be added as **additionally insured** under this policy. Such insurance shall be primary and not require the sharing of any loss by any insurer of the Society.
