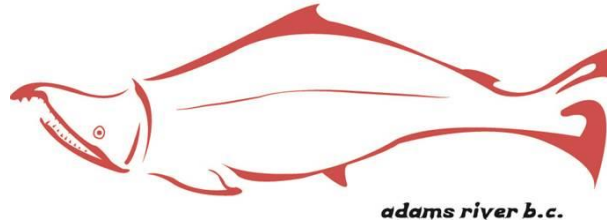


Salute to the Sockeye



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR THE SALUTE TO THE SOCKEYE EVENT 2018

The Adams River Salmon Society invites proposals for the following contract at the Salute to the Sockeye celebration at Tsútswecw Provincial Park (formally Roderick Haig-Brown Provincial Park), Sept. 28 - Oct.21, 2018. Tsútswecw Provincial Park is located on the Squilax-Anglemont Road, 5 km from the Squilax Bridge off the Trans-Canada Highway between Chase and Sorrento, BC. The park is the scene of the world-famous Adams River salmon run where sockeye potentially numbering in the millions return to spawn and attract as many as 230,000 visitors to the spectacle over a three-week period.

The contract area includes the Squilax-Anglemont Highway adjacent to Tsútswecw Provincial Park below the Adams River Bridge to the main entrance of the Park.

Under the supervision of the The Adams River Salmon Society, for the period Sept. 29th, 2018 to Oct. 21, 2018, the contractor will:

- Provide sufficient qualified staff and equipment on a scheduled basis between the hours of 9 am and 4 pm to ensure safe traffic flow entering and exiting the Park on Sept. 29-30, Oct. 6-8, 13-14, 20-21.
- Provide an on-call (with response under one hour) mid-week traffic control service should congestion occur. This service would be delivered “as needed” upon the request of a Society or BC Parks representative.
- The contractor will establish a system of communications with the Society and BC Parks to allow contact in the event of an emergency and shall respond to any such emergency within a reasonable time frame.
- The contractor will liaison with the Ministry of Transportation and local RCMP
- The contractor and its employees shall be neatly attired in an identifiable uniform and/or wearing clearly visible identification as a traffic control person and shall conduct themselves in a friendly, courteous manner at all times.
- Vehicles and equipment on site shall be clean and in good repair and will be operated in a safe and environmentally responsible manner at all times.
- The contractor shall, without limiting its obligations or liabilities herein and at its own expense, insure its operations under a policy of comprehensive general liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 inclusive per occurrence against bodily injury, personal injury, property damage and including liability assumed under contract. The Adams River Salmon Society and the Province of BC are to be added as insured under this policy. Such insurance shall be primary and not require the sharing of any loss by any insurer of the

Society. Automobile liability insurance shall be in place, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000, on all vehicles owned, operated or licensed in the name of the contractor in the course of this contract.

- The contractor shall provide the Society with evidence of required insurance prior to commencement of the services. The contractor shall provide proof of Workers Compensation registration in good standing prior to commencement of the services.

Proponents are advised that The Adams River Salmon Society may reject any or all proposals submitted.
